

Job Opening

Applications are invited from suitable candidates for the post of **two Junior Research Fellow (JRF)** positions, one each for the following two projects, in time-bound SAC-ISRO sponsored projects entitled

1. **Detection of heavy metal pollution in vegetation and characterisation of soil clay minerals using AVIRIS-NG data**
2. **Desertification and Land Degradation: Monitoring, Vulnerability Assessment and Combating Plans”.**

Educational Qualifications: M.Sc./M.Tech. in ICT/Machine learning/Geomatics/Geophysics, including soil science with experience to work in Matlab and commercial image processing software with 60% marks.

Stipend: Rs. 25,000/- pm + 20% HRA.
