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

Nina Sabnani is an artist and storyteller who uses film, illustration and writing to tell her stories. Graduating from the Faculty of Fine Arts, Vadodara she received a master's degree in film from Syracuse University, NY, as a Fulbright Fellow. Her doctoral research at IIT Bombay, focused on the Kaavad

storytelling tradition of Rajasthan. Her work in film and illustrated books, seeks to bring together animation and ethnography. Her award-winning films have been made into illustrated books and translated in many Indian languages. Her passion to explore participatory design has led her to make Hum Chitra Banate Hain (We make Images) with Sher Singh Bhil from Madhya Pradesh won the prestigious National award from the President of India for 2016.



Prof. B.K.Chakravarthy

Prof. B. K. Chakravarthy teaches Innovation by Design at the Industrial Design Centre (IDC), IIT Bombay. He has set up the Shenoy Innovation Studio at IITB, where students and young designers are given the opportunity to work on live projects and benefit from expertise in a range of interrelated fields.

Presently, she is appointed as Director, Mekong-Ganga Cooperation Asian Traditional Textile Museum, Siem Reap, Cambodia.



Chandita Mukherjee

Chandita Mukherjee, is a documentary film maker whose area of work is the science-technologysociety interface. She is interested in the multiple forms of knowledge that co-exist in Indian society, transcending the formal frameworks of science and technology learned and practiced in institutions. Besides

producing works on contemporary themes she has pursued the history of science and technology extensively in her work. She has produced films and photo documentations, set up websites, published print materials, put up exhibitions and festivals. She has been a resource person to a variety of training programmes. Among her awards are the Jules Verne Prize of the European Union for science communication, and two National Awards, one for short fiction and one for science, awarded by the President of India.

Ankit Chadha

Ankit Chadha, a Dastango, weaves research-based narratives performed in the Dastangoi form of Urdu storytelling. His writing varies from biographical accounts of personalities like Kabir to Dara Shikoh. Ankit has worked with non-profits to create modern tales on sustainable lifestyles, hunger and the

Internet. He has spoken on Dastangoi globally, including Harvard, Yale and University of Toronto. Ankit has innovated the form of 'Musical Narrative' that uniquely brings together stories and music. He has also worked on Dastangoi performances for children, adapting classics including Alice, The Phantom Tollbooth, and The Little Prince. He is the author of "Amir Khusrau - The Man in Riddles" and "My Gandhi Story" co-authored with Nina Sabnani and Rajesh Chaity Vengad.

Prof. Suchitra Balasubrahmanyan

Suchitra Balasubrahmanyan studied Visual Communication at the National Institute of Design, Ahmedabad and has a PhD in design history from CEPT University, Ahmedabad. Her doctoral work focussed on the global-local

contexts of the genesis of modern design education in India after independence. Suchitra's professional design practice has centred on social communication design, exploring a variety of issues ranging from women's health, child rights, primary education, minority rights, communalism and globalisation in rural and urban India.



Prof. Binita Desai

Binita Desai is currently a Professor at the Dhirubhai Ambani Institute of Information and Communication Technology, Gandhinagar, Gujarat since 2002. She is a practicing professional in the areas of Graphic Design and Animation and teaches undergraduate and post graduate students at DAIICT.

She graduated from the Maharaja Sayajirao University, Faculty of Fine Arts, Baroda, Gujarat, in 1985. She subsequently received her Animation training from the National Institute of Design from 1980-85, and has worked as a design professional and taught at the National Institute of Design till 1985-1997, and was a freelance designer from 1997-2002.



Geetanjali Sachdev

Geetanjali Sachdev is an art and design pedagogue and practitioner. She has been involved in framing interdisciplinary pedagogical frameworks for academic programs in art and design, at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels. Her art and design practice includes working with handmade, screen-

printed and recycled paper. At Srishti, her roles have included deanship of the post-graduate and advanced diploma programs, chairing admissions, and coordinating the foundation studies and core skills programs. Geetanjali is currently doing her PhD in Art & Design at Srishti through which she is exploring art and design pedagogies for plant representations. She teaches courses related to food, patterns, motifs and decorative street art.



Rashmi Korjan

Rashmi set up the country's first all woman product design firm, The Design Concern, along with her classmate in the early eighties soon after completing her studies in Product Design at NID Ahmedabad. She is a co-founder of Studio Korjan and has been instrumental in many successful design projects.

She is interested in ways of understanding and thinking about design processes, how designers think, and methods of mapping and modelling of ideas. She teaches Design at various institutions including NID Ahmedabad, CEPT University Ahmedabad, NIFT Gandhinagar, IICD Jaipur, School of Engineering and Applied Sciences, Ahmedabad University. Courses she offers include Design Concepts and Concerns, User Centred Design, Visual Thinking, Geometrical Construction, and Design Research.



Prof. Mookesh Patel

Prof. Mookesh Patel, Dean at Indian School of Design and Innovation [ISDI] and Professor Emeritus at Arizona State University, is a former Chair of Department Visual Communication at Herberger Institute for Design and the Arts. He received his MFA in communication design from Rhode Island School

of Design. He holds a diploma in Visual Communication from the National Institute of Design, and a BS from Ahmedabad Science College, Gujarat University, India. He is a practicing information and experience designer at Chánchal, (USA) and His clients include Arizona State Land Development, Phoenix Art Museum, and Metropolitan Boston Transit Authority for Malcolm Grear Designers. He is the recipient of a Fulbright Research Scholar Grant, United Nations Development Program Grant, and other awards.



Prof. P Kumaresan

Kumaresan is Assistant Professor, Product Design at Industrial Design Centre, IIT Bombay. He has been involved in a variety of areas ranging from craft to ICT products and prototyping. 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Financial Proposal for offering Machine Learning Course for JAU UG students

Subsequent to successful completion of Refresher's Course on **Mathematics and Basic Programming**, an autumn semester course on **Machine Learning** is being delivered for the same students in audiovisual mode from DAIICT. The course started on August 2018 and will continue till December 2018.

As suggested by JAU, lectures will be delivered on every Thursday and Friday for one hour each (total 2 hrs.) in AV mode, while practical/tutorials will be conducted on site at JAU on every Saturday for two hours. For tutorials/practical, one TA will be visiting to JAU on Friday night and return on Sunday morning. It is envisaged that lodging arrangement will be made for the TA by JAU.

The present document presents the financial proposal for offering of ML course to approximately 100 students at three different locations e.g. Junagadh, Amreli and Veraval. The proposal is based on the course hours to be delivered by the DAIICT faculties.
