

## ADJUNCT FACULTY GUIDELINES & REMUNERATION POLICY

The following guidelines and policy are applicable to international faculty who are appointed as adjunct faculty.

### A. Visa information:

Foreign nationals visiting the Institute to engage in teaching or research collaborations are advised to travel on a business visa to India, wherever applicable.

### B. Activities:

1. An adjunct faculty may visit the Institute to teach credit-based courses.
  - Adjunct faculty shall submit a course proposal to Dean (AP) at least one semester in advance.
  - A course having 1 credit shall run for a minimum of 12 lecture hours, and for a period of not less than 5 working days. A course with 2 credits will have a minimum of 24 lecture hours and a period of not less 10 working days.
  - Institute will bear the cost of air travel in economy class, as well as visa fees.
  - The honorarium shall be @ USD 60 per 1 hour lecture. Institute will bear the Indian tax liability as applicable.


