With reference to your application and subsequent screening, we are pleased to inform you that your project proposal titled '*IoT Enabled, Self-Calibrating and Self-Healing Sensor System for In-situ Agriculture Applications*', has been selected for the **TIH-IoT CHANAKYA Group (PhD, PG & UG) Fellowship Program, 2021-2022**, being implemented by TIH Foundation for IoT and IoE, IIT Bombay (TIH-IoT).

- 1) The project has been approved for a grant not exceeding an aggregate amount of **Rs Twenty-Eight Lakhs Ten Thousand Five Hundred and Sixty only. (28, 10,560/-)** for a duration of **4 years and 0 months**, starting **January 17, 2022 to be executed at the host institute, Dhirubhai Ambani Institute of Information and Communication Technology (DAIICT)** The project duration can be extended for a maximum period of one year or till the completion of the degree of the PhD student, whichever is lesser.
- 2) The students proposed by you to work on the project, will be entitled to the TIH-IoT CHANAKYA Group (PhD, PG & UG) fellowship based on the following guidelines:
  - a) PhD Student - **Rs 31,000 per month** for the first & the second year of PhD, and **Rs 35,000 per month** for the third, the fourth and the fifth year (if approved) of PhD. PhD student will also be entitled to HRA at the rate of 24% of the fellowship amount.
  - b) PG Student - **Rs 12,400** per month up-to 2 years
  - c) UG Student - **Rs 10,000/-** per month up-to 10 months

Additionally, support for the project in the form of a Project Development Fund of up-to **Rs 2,00,000/-** will be provided (not to be utilized for Capital Expenditure).

- 3) The details of the grant and annual disbursal schedule is mentioned in table 1 below:

**A. Roles & Responsibilities:**

supervisor/mentor, which are required to be submitted before joining the fellowship or may be called upon to do so subsequently.

- 2) The TIH-IoT shall be within its right(s) to verify the genuineness/correctness of such information at any time now or in future. If it is found at any stage that the information provided is incorrect or some information is concealed/suppressed, then the grant and the engagement hereunder will be automatically cancelled.

**C. Termination/Separation:**

- 1) TIH-IoT CHANAKYA Group Fellowship shall expire after the approved project duration or completion of the project or completion of the degree of the PhD student, whichever is earlier or in the event it is terminated by TIH-IoT at its sole determination.
- 2) During the stipulated period, if the progress of the project or conduct or performance of students is found unsatisfactory, the grant shall be discontinued without any notice and without assigning any reason(s) thereof.
- 3) In the event of breach of any of the terms & conditions of grant,
  - a) TIH-IoT reserves the right to claim liquidated damages from you, apart from other damages.
  - b) TIH-IoT also reserves the right to terminate TIH-IoT CHANAKYA Group Fellowship grant without giving any notice.
  - c) TIH-IoT (entirely at its discretion) also reserves the right to recover any monies/funds/damages that flow or result from such termination.

**D. General Terms & Conditions:**

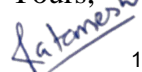
- 1) TIH-IoT CHANAKYA Group (PhD, PG & UG) Fellowship Grant is non-transferrable in nature.

- 3) The students have been engaged as “TIH-IoT CHANAKYA fellow/intern” by the TIH-IoT under the CHANAKYA program funded by Department of Science and Technology under the NM-ICPS and therefore in addition to the terms of this Sanction letter, you shall also adhere to and abide by any rules, ordinances, guidelines, directions issued by DST from time to time.
- 4) You shall submit utilization certificate and audited statement of expenditure at the end of each financial year.
- 5) Subsequent release of grant under the project shall be considered based on the financial record submitted by you.
- 6) At the end of the project, you shall submit an audited statement of accounts of the entire grant received, countersigned by the finance officer of the institute. Unspent balance, if
