As graduates of DAIICT you are among a privileged group of young Indians who have had access to an excellent standard of higher education. I congratulate all of you for completing your course of study with diligence and sincerity. You are now ready to embark on the next phase of your professional journey and make a positive difference to the many lives you will touch on the way.

DAIICT has endeavored to give you a holistic education that opens up many pathways for you to learn, grow and excel in a rapidly changing world.

In this context, let me share with you our long-term vision for the Institute. While we take pride in pioneering ICT education and research in India, we now plan to introduce academic programs that speak to a new generation of communication technologies, services and applications. We are in the process of launching UG/PG programs on AI and ML, Data Science, Digital Informatics, VLSI, NLP and Design by 2023 - 2024.

We have also initiated the process of re-structuring our curriculum in ways that offer a rich, flexible and meaningful educational experience for our undergraduates. The multi-disciplinary thrust of our ICT programme will be consolidated and expanded through the introduction of Minors in the areas of Liberal Studies, Natural Sciences and Design. Our students will be free to curate their programme of study in accordance with their interests and aspirations.

With these initiatives in place, we hope to attract a more diverse student community from across the nation and the world and increase our strength to 3000+ by 2028. To achieve this objective, we have planned a whole new phase of expansion of our infrastructure including halls of residence, classrooms, labs and recreational spaces. The future growth of the Institute will also be an inclusive one. We will continue to strengthen our practices and policies of providing equal opportunities and resources for students who come from disadvantaged or marginalized contexts.

But even as we give shape to the future of the institute, Imust also take this opportunity to share with you some of our more recent achievements. I am pleased that our institutional, faculty and student achievements for the years 2020-22 continue to be robust and inspiring. I record these here for your perusal.

For your information, the Institute has introduced one BTech Program in Maths & Computing (MnC), one PG program — MSc in Data Science (DS) from the academic year 2020. A new PG program — MSc in Agri Analytics is introduced in the current academic year 2022-23. This is an unique programme in collaboration with Anand Agriculture University, (AAU), Gujarat and Indian Institute of Remote Sensing (IIRS), Dehradun — an academic wing of Dept. of Space. DAIICT is the degree awarding institute whereas IIRS and AAU will transfer the credits to DAIICT.

PLACEMENT ACTIVITIES

Placement activities were brisk and encouraging all these years at DA-IICT:

In 20-21, 147 companies visited the Institute. 391 students were placed. The highest salary offered was

Rs.51.75 LPA by Atlassian. The median salary was 10 LPA.

In 2021-22, 157 companies visited the Institute. 448 students were placed. The highest salary offered was Rs.54.22 LPA by Google and median salary was Rs.13.5 LPA.

For the current and ongoing 2022-23 placement activities, 131 companies visited our campus. 465 students are already placed. The highest salary offered is Rs.82.0 LPA by Atlassian and the median salary is Rs.12.88 LPA

INSTITUTIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS

DA-IICT received the Centre of Excellence (CoE) award from the Government of Gujarat in January 2022. The selection was made after a series of verification and assessment of overall achievements of the Institute by the Government of Gujarat appointed expert committees.

In October 2022, the Institute also received '5 Star' award of Gujarat State Institutional Ranking Framework (GSIRF), Govt. of Gujarat.

In 2020-22 Academic year DAIICT signed Memorandum of Understanding to foster academic exchange and cooperation with about 15 Institutions/Organizations. The objectives of the MoUs are to promote collaborative research projects, cooperative learning, faculty student and staff exchange and Visiting Scholar programs.

DA-IICT was awarded DST-FIST Grant (Level 1) of INA 57 lakh. The number of proposals shortlisted under the FIST 2019 call (Engineering Sciences) is 16 out of the total 218 proposals submitted nationwide

DA-IICT collaborated with SAS (American multinational developer of analytics software with 40+ years of experience) to launch a two-year full-time Master of Science in Data Science (M.Sc. Data Science) from 2020. The programme is designed to address the new paradigm of fact-based decision making associated with the advent of Big Data.

FACULTY ACHIEVEMENTS

Prof Hemant A. Patil was elected as ISCA (International Speech Communication Association) Distinguished Lecturer for the year 2020-21. Prof Patil was also APSIPA Distinguished Lecturer during 2018-2019. This recognition is towards his joint research work in the field of Speech and Speaker Recognition, Anti-Spoofing Methods for Automatic Speaker Recognition, etc. primarily with the members of the Speech Research Lab at DA-IICT, Prof. Patil is the first Indian scientist working in an Indian university getting this international recognition of ISCA DL. He was appointed Associate Editor of IEEE Signal Processing Magazine-Columns and Forum. He is part of a small group of Associate Editors who are from reputed Universities and Research Institutions around the world.

Prof Bhaskar Chaudhury (DA-IICT, India) along with Prof. Matthias Ehrhardt (University of Wuppertal, Germany) and Prof Vrushali Bokil (Oregon State University, USA) edited a special issue titled "Finite Difference Methods: Recent Developments and Applications in Computational Science" in Elsevier Journal of Computational Science (2020). He is also the Project Investigator for two research projects of two-year duration by the Gujarat Council of Science

and Technology (GUJCOST). These are titled 'Design and Implementation of a visibility improvement model for haze removal in images acquired from real time CCTV cameras' and 'A Forensic tool for Land Revenue Documents Forgery Detection.' The coinvestigators are **Professors Ahlad Kumar** and **Priyanka Singh** respectively.

Prof Yash Vasavada also launched a new research lab called CSPMI (Communication, Signal Processing, and Machine Intelligence) Lab with ISRO funding support of Rs. 1.25 Crore. This Lab has five on-going research projects with five faculty members as the Pls/Co-Pls and eight JRFs, including five MTech students and one PhD Scholar.

Prof Manish Khare was invited to serve as Guest Editor for two Special Issues of the Journal 'Multimedia Tools and Applications' on 'Machine Vision Theory and Applications for Cyber-Physical Systems' and 'Machine Vision Theory and Application for Cyper-Physical Systems.' He has received the Best Special Session Award in the 13th Asian Conference on Intelligent Information and Database Systems (ACIIDS 2021), 07-09 April 2021, Phuket, Thailand. The title of the session was 'Special Session on Computational Imaging and Vision (CIV 2021).'

A consortium of Institutes, including **Prof. Prasenjit Mazumdar** of DAIICT has been awarded a prestigious project titled 'National Language Translation Mission (NLTM): BHASHINI' from MeitY in February, 2022.

Ms Madhu Rayappa Kamble, a PhD scholar at DA-IICT associated with Speech Research Lab, got a Post-Doctoral position from EURECOM, France. Ms Kamble has an impressive list of publications, a 6-month internship experience at Samsung Research Institute, Bangalore. She has also received several

The work was presented at IEEE MTT-S International Microwave and RF Conference (IMARC) at IIT, Bombay. Pratik Ghosh also secured the second position in the student activity program in IMARC, IIT Bombay.

Ankit Kumar, 4th-year BTech student's paper titled 'Evaluation of Deep Learning-Based Human Expression Recognition on Noisy Images' has been accepted by the 7th International Conference on Soft Computing and Machine Intelligence to be held in Stockholm, Sweden.

Meet Patel, a 3rd-year BTech student, was selected in Google Summer of Code (GSoC), 2020. He worked for 12 weeks under the organization Percona, developing various open-source tools utilizing a wide range of technology stack.

BTech students, **Janvi Bhagiya**, **Simran Nagrani and Jahnavi Gupta** secured an internship at Microsoft in their second year and went for their second internship this summer at Microsoft. They got selected through the Microsoft CODESS event.

Nishant Shah, a third year BTech (ICT) with minor in CS student achieved a Global Rank 5 and National Rank 1 in the Google Kickstart Round G 2020 among 8000+ participants.
