Obituary- Professor Suman Mitra

Professor Suman Mitra was the Dean of the Academic Program from 2013 to 2020. He was a brilliant teacher, an outstanding researcher and an epitome of kindness. He was always compassionate and gentle. Professor Mitra will forever be a part of the countless futures he helped create at DA-IICT. His students and his colleagues at the Institute will forever miss his guidance and reassuring presence.

EXPERT LECTURES


