- The bidder should invariably submit bid documents in sealed covers.
- All documents issued to tenderers for the purpose of tendering shall be submitted by him only duly filled in and signed on every page as a token of acceptance of conditions and completed in all respect.
- Material details (make/model), methodology, dimensions etc. shall be provided.
- The contractor must study the quantities and specifications / make & model of material before quoting the rates.
- **Security Deposit:** 5% of total order value to be deposited with DAU in 7 working days after receipt of work order. The same amount will be returned in 30 days after completion of project and completion of punch points/balance works. No interest shall be paid on Security Deposit amount. Client reserves the right to encase or deducts any sum due to failure of any conditions of contract without reference to contractor.

- **Rejection of Bid:**
 - Dhirubhai Ambani University reserves the right to reject any Bid, and the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected Bidder(s) of the grounds for such decision.
- **Award of Contract:**
 - Award Criteria: The Criteria for selection will be the lowest cost for the technically qualified bids.
 - In case, the lowest bidder (L1) does not accept the award of contract or found to be involved in corrupt and/or fraudulent practices, the client shall decide next bidder to be awarded the contract.
- **General Terms and conditions:**
- The Contractor will maintain the equipment and other properties of DAU in good condition. Damage to any equipment, appliances and other properties (both movable and immovable of DAU due to negligence. Commission /omission of the contractor or his employees or agents shall be brought to the notice of the DAU for recovery of such damages from the amounts payable to the Contractor.
- The Contractor shall be responsible for loading, unloading, shifting, safety and security of their material, tools & tackles.

- The Contractor shall be responsible for boarding and lodging of their manpower with require safety, security, proper supervision on movement and liasioning work.
- The Contractor shall be responsible for cleaning of sites/area etc. complete.
- The total tender value shall include all taxes, levies / duties paid or payable in execution of the contract. cost of transportation, lodging & unloading, lodging & boarding of Contractor's employee. Also include cost of labour, tools tackles etc.
- Contractor shall make himself and their staff fully conversant with the locations and the type of job be carried out therein so that he clearly understands the scope of work and assess the requirement of resources required to complete the work. The Contractor shall contact the Contract Administrator for this purpose.
- DAU reserve the right to off load or total quantum of the job depending upon the exigencies.
- Material used shall be strictly as per specifications / Make & Model.
- Water & power shall be provided at one convenient point at free of cost by owner. If wastage of supplied water & electricity is made by contractor's labour, reasonable amount shall be recovered from contractor's bill as compensation.
- There shall be no objection from the contractor for any other agencies working on the same site.
- The contractor shall have to give detailed working schedule of the execution for the work justifying expected progress of work. If the progress of the work is not satisfactory, a second agency shall be employed by the client for some part of same work.
- In case the Contractor fails to provide any services in time or fails to ensure the job carried out at the fullest satisfaction of the Contract Administrator, whose decision will be final and binding on the Contractor. The Institute has every rights to engage another agency or get the job done by employing any other Contractor and the charges for the same together with consequential expenses incurred / losses suffered by the Institute will be recovered from the Contractor.
- The Contractor shall subject to the provisions of the contract and with the care and diligence execute and maintain the works and provide all labour including, the supervision thereof.
- The Contractor shall take full responsibility for the adequacy, stability and safety of all site operations and methods of construction, provided that the contractor shall not be responsible, except as may be expressly provided in the contract, for the design or specification of the permanent works, or for the design or specification of any temporary works prepared by the Architect/ Project manager.
- The Engineer shall be at liberty to object to and require the Contractor to remove forthwith from the work any person employed by the Contractor in or about the execution of maintenance of the works who, in the opinion of the Engineer, misconducts himself, or is incompetent or negligent in the proper performance of his duties or who employment is otherwise considered by the Engineer to be undesirable and such person shall not be again employed upon the works without the written permission of the Engineer.
- Apart from one-year overall execution warranty the bidder shall mention warranty against each item as per manufacturer's policy.
- **Workmen Compensation Act:**
- The contractor shall make payment of compensation in case of accidental injury during maintenance work in accordance with the provisions of Act. the contractor shall insure all of his workman under the Workmen Compensation Act by way by taking an Insurance Policy to cover himself against all claims and shall extend these legal heir within the specified time.
- Contractor to follow all safety norms.
- All statutory liabilities towards contractor's employee shall be sole responsibility of the Contractor.
- The entry to the project site is prohibited for minor labor and labor with minors.
- **Maintenance Service:**
 - Free maintenance services shall be provided by the Contractor during the period of warranty.
 - In case, contractor is not providing satisfactory support & doing delay in providing warranty support, DAU reserves right to repair / rectify at risk & cost of the Contractor.
- **Scope of contractor:**
- To carry out the jobs in a manner as per instruction of CA. job to be performed at all heights and locations using necessary scaffolding/ ladders with all safety measures.

- Providing certificate for manufacturing warranty/guarantee on legal documents, test reports, project reports wherever applicable.
- The contractor shall complete this work within 1 month from the date of possession of site or from the date of work order whichever is later.
- A full time qualified and experienced supervisor shall be kept in charge of the execution.
- The site shall be cleared totally after the completion of work to the satisfaction of Engineer In Charge/Client.
- Shifting of all kinds of raw material from designated site to working site and shifting of debris from working site to designated place.
- **Termination:** Contract can be terminated within the contract period at the discretion of DAU by giving simple notice without assigning any reason thereof.
- **Defective work:** charges for rectification of defective work and other consequent damages to DAU shall be borne by the contractor.
- **Disputes:** Any disputes and /or difference of opinion arising out of the work concerning this shall be referred to the director of the institute whose decision shall be final and binding on you. All legal disputes arising out of this contract will be subject to Gandhinagar jurisdiction.
- **Payment:** The contractor will be submitted running account bill for the work completed with measurement in phase manner, and will be released in 30 days after deduction of retention and applicable taxes. For advance payment will be on mutual agreeable.
- **Advance Payment:** 30% of basic order value to be paid as an advance against submission of same value cheque as guarantee. The advance will be adjusted from each RA / Final bill.
- **Retention money:** 5% of basic value of each RA / Final Bill shall be retained.
- **Release of retention money:** Total retained money will be released after completion of defect liability period from the date of completion of project subject to rectification of punch points during defect liability period.

QUANTITY SURVEYING

The Contractor will himself undertake the quantity surveying work and submit his bills in case he fails to submit his bills in proper order, the Employer reserves for himself the right employ and expert who will also be employed, if the bills stated by the Contractor show in accuracies frequently indicating that Contractor is no capable of taking the required measurements and producing a proper bill. The Contractor [or the expert] will make the measurements on the basis of the drawings in as far as it is practicable. The billing procedure and formats shall be as approved by the Engineer. The remuneration of such an expert will be deducted from the Contractor's bills.

DELAY AND EXTENSION OF TIME

If the contractor shall desire an extension of the time for completion of the work on the ground of his having been unavoidably hindered in its execution or any other ground, he shall apply in writing to the EIC/CA before the expiration of the period stipulated in the tender or before the expiration of 30 days from the date on which he was hindered as aforesaid or on which cause for extension occurred, whichever is earlier and EIC/CA may, if in his opinion, believe that there are reasonable grounds for granting an extension, grant such extension, as he thinks necessary or proper. The decision of the EIC/CA in this matter shall be final.

CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION OF WORK.

When the whole of the works have been substantially completed the Contractor may give a notice to that effect to the EIC. Such notice shall be deemed to be a request by the contractor for the Engineer to issue a request by the Contractor for the Engineer to issue a certificate of completion in respect of the works. The Engineer shall, within fourteen days of the date of delivery of such notice either issue to the Contractor, with a copy to the Employer, a certificate of completion stating the date on which, in his opinion, the work's were substantially completed in accordance with the contract or give instructions in writing to contractor or give instruction in writing to contractor specifying all the work which, in the Engineer's opinion, requires to be done by the Contractor before the issue of such certificate. The Engineer shall also notify the completion that may appear after such instructions and before completion of the works specified therein. The Contractor within fourteen days of completion to the satisfactions of the Engineer of the works so specified and making good any defects so notified.
